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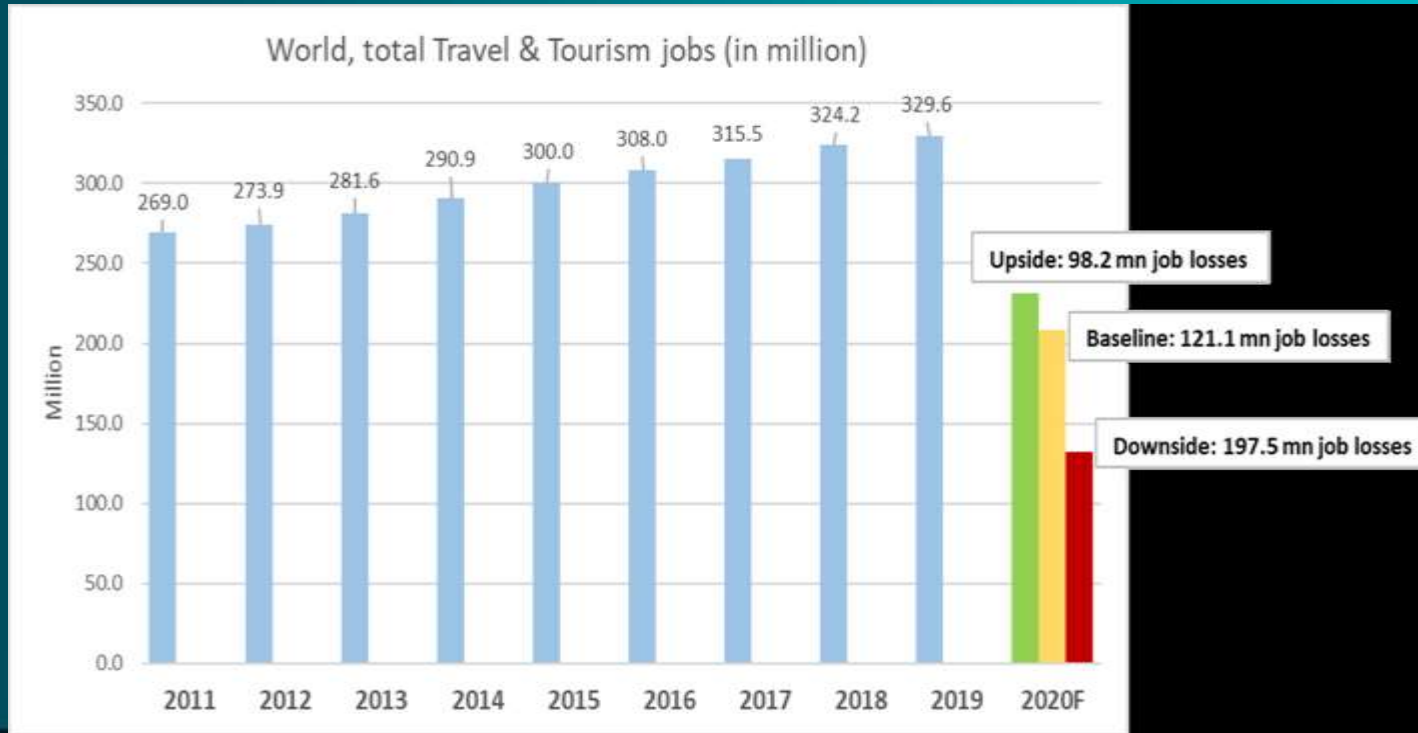

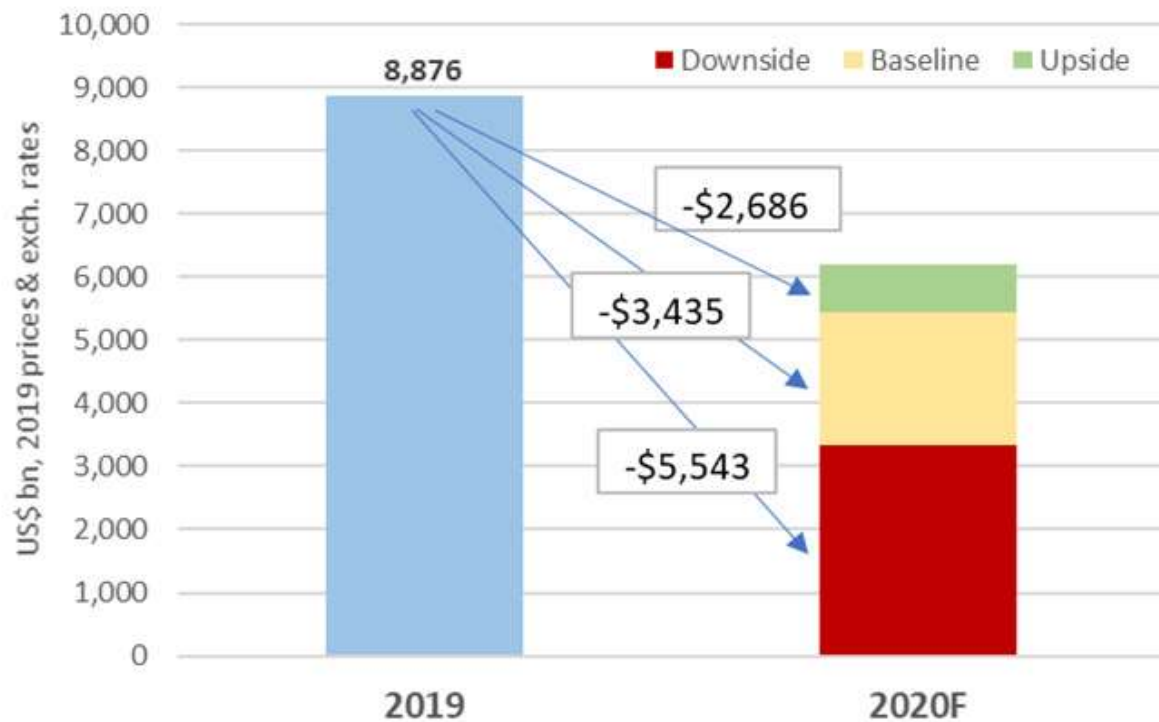

Challenges for The Industry

- More Than 100 Countries have Travel Restrictions.
- The global revenue for the travel and tourism industry will be an estimated 447.4 billion U.S. dollars in 2020 - a decrease of around 34.7 percent from the previous year.
- The revenue for the travel and tourism industry in India will be badly affected by the pandemic, and expected to be 5 trillion rupees less in 2020 than the previous year .
- Tourism sector in India is staring at a potential job loss of around 38 million, which is around 70% of the total workforce.



- As a result of the pandemic, the global hotel market has already taken a huge hit. The country that saw the largest drop in occupancy was Italy - dropping as much as 96 percent when compared to the previous year. In India it is expected to be 65% decline in hotel occupancy.
- Approximately 314 billion US dollar loss in Aviation sector World Wide.
- 28% Tour Operators around the globe are on the verge of closing.
- Psychological Problems with travelers will persist.
